THE PRO LIFE ACTIVITIES WERE VARIOUS AND INCLUDED ACTIVELY PARTICIPATING IN THE RUNNING OF THE SILVER ROSE, SPONSORING A PRO LIFE PROJECT PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO A PRO LIFE ORGANIZATION, COUNCIL PARTICIPATION IN THE ANNUAL LIFE CHAIN, AND THE ORDERING OF PRO LIFE INSERTS FROM SUPREME THAT WERE THEN DISTRIBUTED TO THE OLF CHURCH MEMBERS.

COUNCIL PROGRAM ACTIVITIES WERE ONCE AGAIN MOST SUCCESSFUL THIS PAST YEAR AS LEAD BY TED RENN. VINCENT DE PAUL FOOD PANTRY, ASSISTING THE NEEDY OF THE GULF COAST THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN FOOD AND CLOTHING DRIVES AND PERFORMING PRISON MINISTRY.

IN SHORT, COUNCIL 9409 DID A LOT OF "GOOD" THIS YEAR FOR THE COMMUNITY AND OUR PARISH . WE MAY NOT HAVE HAD THAT ONE REAL BIG AMAZING SIGNATURE PROJECT, BUT WE MADE A LOT OF BASE HITS, AND WE JUST KEEP DOING OUR THING, AND THAT IS SUPPORTING OUR OWN AND BEING THERE FOR OUR PARISH PRIEST'S AND OTHERS, AS THEY NEEDED A LITTLE HELP. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED SEVERAL THANK YOU NOTES AND LETTERS FROM THOSE PEOPLE AND ORGANIZATIONS THAT COUNCIL 9409 REACHED OUT TO SUPPORT AND HELP THIS PAST YEAR.

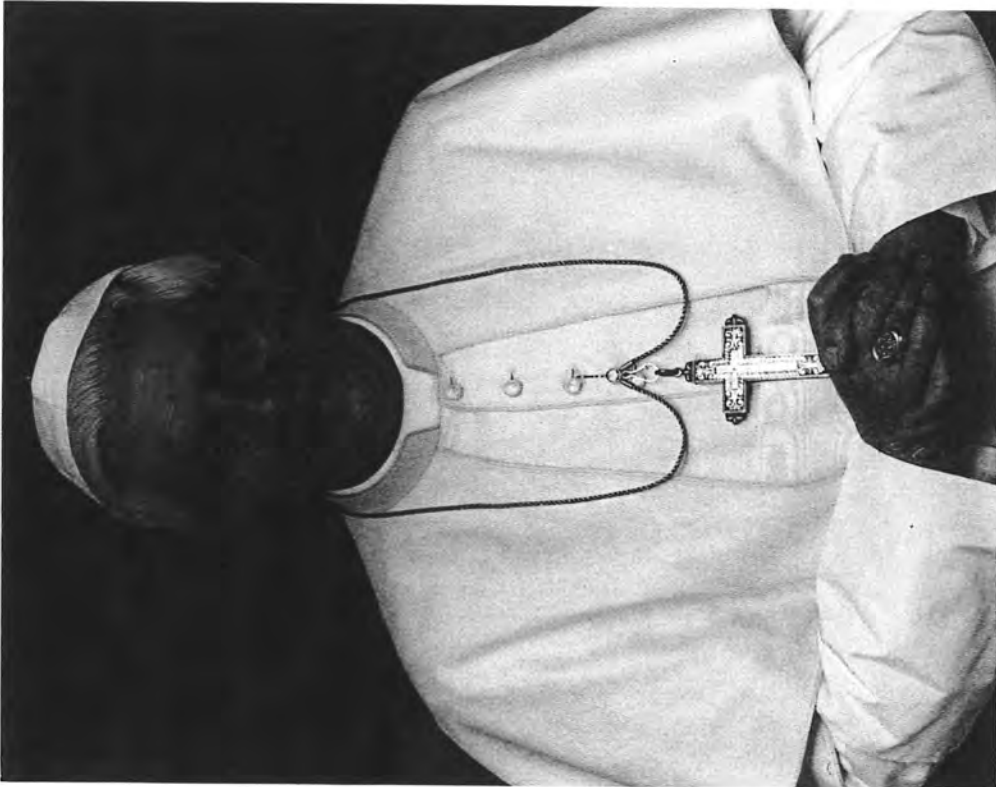
