

Resolution

In Support of St. Jude Children's Research Hospital

Whereas, St. Jude is the only pediatric cancer research center where families never pay for treatments that are not covered by insurance and no child is ever denied treatment because of the family's inability to pay, including the cost of treatment, housing, transportation, and meals.

Whereas, the daily operating costs of \$1.8 million is primarily covered by public contributions averaging only \$31 each and during the last five years eighty-one cents of every dollar received has supported research and patient care.

Whereas, on average, 7,800 active patients visit St. Jude each year, children from every state in the U.S. and around the world and cancer is the #1 KILLER by disease, of children under one year in the U.S. and more than 10,000 children in the U.S. alone are diagnosed with cancer each year.

Whereas, St. Jude Children's Research Hospital has developed research and treatments that have helped push overall survival rates for childhood cancers from less than 20 percent when the hospital opened in 1962 to 80 percent today and the survival rate for acute lymphoblastic leukemia, the most common form of childhood cancer, has increased from just 4 percent to 94 percent thanks to St. Jude's groundbreaking protocols and clinical care.

Whereas, St. Jude also has one of the largest sickle cell research and treatment centers in the country.


Whereas, St. Jude Children's Research Hospital has a long tradition and relationship with the Catholic Church and the Archdiocese of Memphis.

Whereas, a similar relationship with the Knights of Columbus in Mississippi would be a public relations bonanza in a largely protestant state and would serve to promote and improve our "Brand", which in turn would help all of our other programs.
