## Nominating an Individual for Election to State Office

## **Recommended Procedure for Councils**

- 1. In January, before the State Convention, the member notifies the Grand Knight of his home council that he is interested in being nominated.
- 2. The council, by a vote of the membership, adopts a resolution supporting the member for election to state office.
- 3. The Grand Knight distributes the adopted resolution to state officers and through the Good of the Order e-mail to other councils in the state by 15 February 2025.
- 4. At the convention:
  - nominations are only made from the floor during the Sunday business session
  - candidates should identify a delegate to make the nomination and a delegate who is not a member of his home council to second the nomination.
