Council News

The meeting was called to order by GK George LaFontaine 6PM with 13 members present in attendance. A motion to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting and to approve the same was made and approved.

Financial reports:

Reports were submitted from the Financial Secretary Harold Hardin and Treasurer Robert Munroe.

New Business:

- Pancake Breakfasts will resume starting Sept 8. We hope to have a formal sign created to advertise the breakfasts in the weekends prior and moving forward to encourage attendance by the parish.
- Knights who Usher should be at the upcoming 10:30AM Mass on Aug 18. Please wear your red polo shirt or a plain red polo shirt. If unable to attend, you need to please find a replacement.
- GK George LaFontaine is in the process of negotiating an order for new red polos and working t-shirts with Harrell Printwear LLC. Once the quote is received it will be presented to the Council and Assembly for initial orders and to have a supply available for new members in 2024-2025. Council polos will be red and Assembly polo shirts will be gray. A work t-shirt will be offered also which may double for the runner's shirts for the K of C convention 2025. The work t-shirt will be a camouflage motif with blue in it versus all brownish. Knights of Columbus will be on the back of it.

- Robert Munroe made a motion which was seconded and approved to appropriate \$500 for E J Martin via the Refund Support Vocations Program (RSVP) for the balance of 2024 A separate motion was duly made and approved to appropriate \$500 for his second semester 2025 to be disbursed in a similar fashion. A similar motion was made by Mike Hart to continue our ongoing support for Grayson Foley in the same fashion.
- Discussion was had over the ongoing situation with the warmer in the kitchen. Mike Hart updated all present that the costs for even a used warmer were perhaps prohibitive. TBD
- Guy Heying brought up the need for insurance coverage for both Council and Assembly members and
 activities. FS Harold Hardin who is also the Faithful Comptroller for the Assembly will look into Assembly
 coverage which would be the same \$2.20 per member as the Council.
